We thank you for your 2013 orders. Here is information and book reviews of new titles available now.

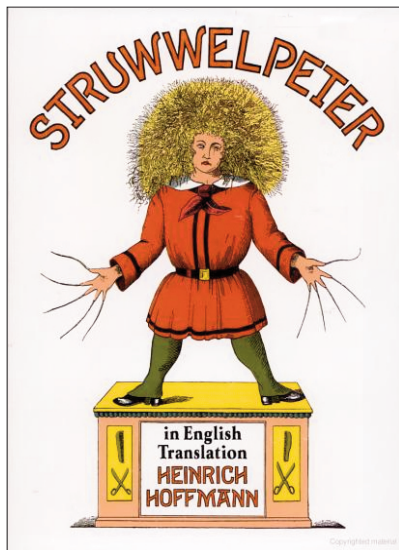
### *Among New and Favorite Penfield Titles*

The *Struwwelpeter* (\$6.95 retail) children's book about a naughty German boy has inspired Dover Books to create new titles *Slovenly Betsy* (\$12.99 retail) and *Slovenly Kate* (\$12.99). These books are 8.5x11 inches and have the quaintly illustrated verses of Heinrich Hoffman. They were incredibly popular in the 1850s and today still delightful. 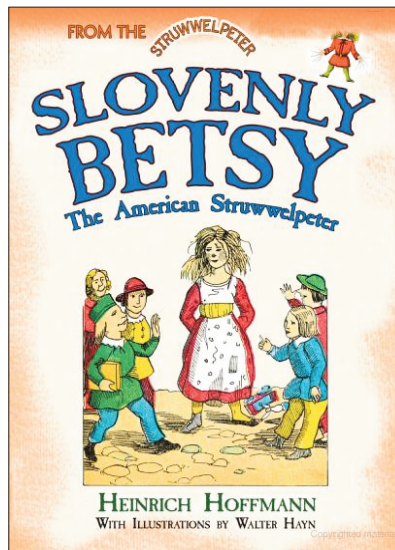

Toni Brendel's revised book *Lidice* (\$16.95) is once again telling the story of the destruction of the people and their village in the former Czechoslovakia.

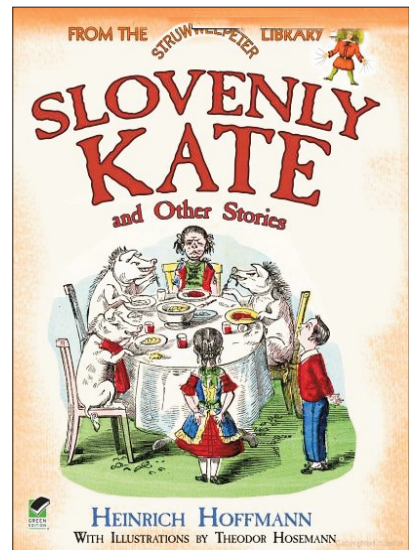
